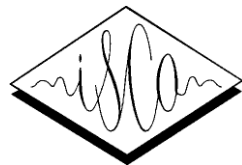
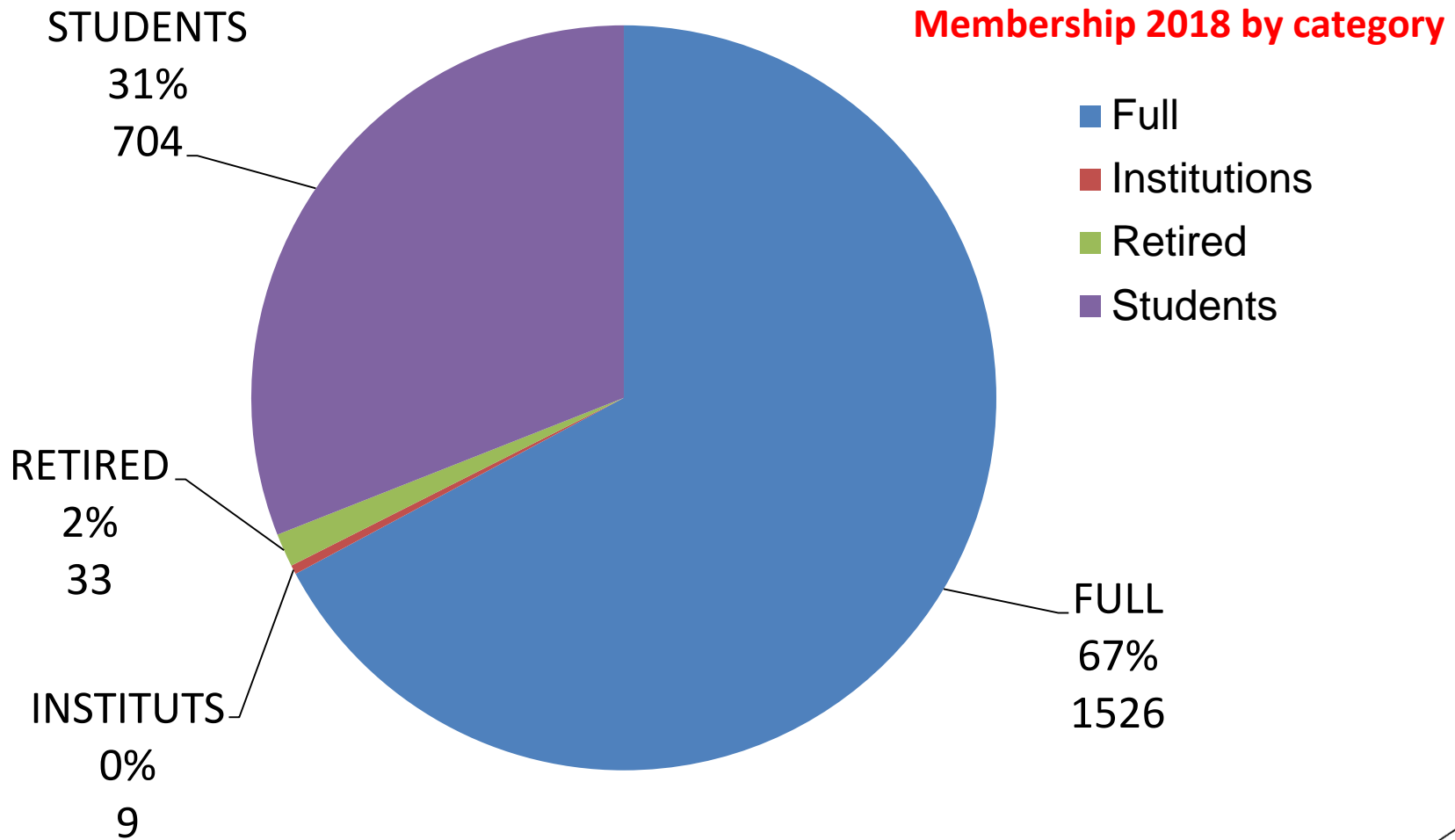
## ISCA Membership from 2001 to 2018 by category

- ◆ ISCA Publication Rule Enforcement: during 2017/18, ISCA oversaw and ruled on one Publication Violation.
- ◆ Publications FAQ: ISCA monitors and responds to information requests (weekly!). Example:
  - ◆ FAQ: “Can I place a copy of my paper in my institutional or other repositories?”
  - ◆ Answer: Yes, you can, on the condition that it is correctly referenced with the proceeding information (e.g. INTERSPEECH) including DOI.

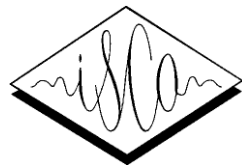
# Treasurer's Report: Overview

## ◆ ISCA primary sources of income:

- ◆ Membership fees ≈ €75k/yr
- ◆ Required donation from Interspeech: ≈ €50k/yr
- ◆ Special donations from IS2010 and IS2015, in support of extra student travel grants (2010, 2015) and in support of the new Interspeech Risk Fund (2015)

## ◆ ISCA primary expenses:

- ◆ Secretariat, salaries, meetings, publishing, website: ≈ €70k/yr
- ◆ DLs, Training, Workshops, Student activities: ≈ €30k/yr

  - ◆ €32k/yr during the IS2015 special donation, 2016-2018

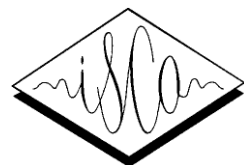

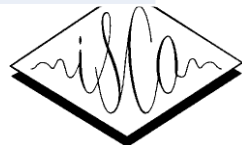

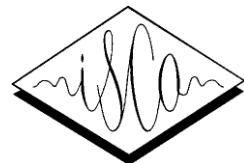

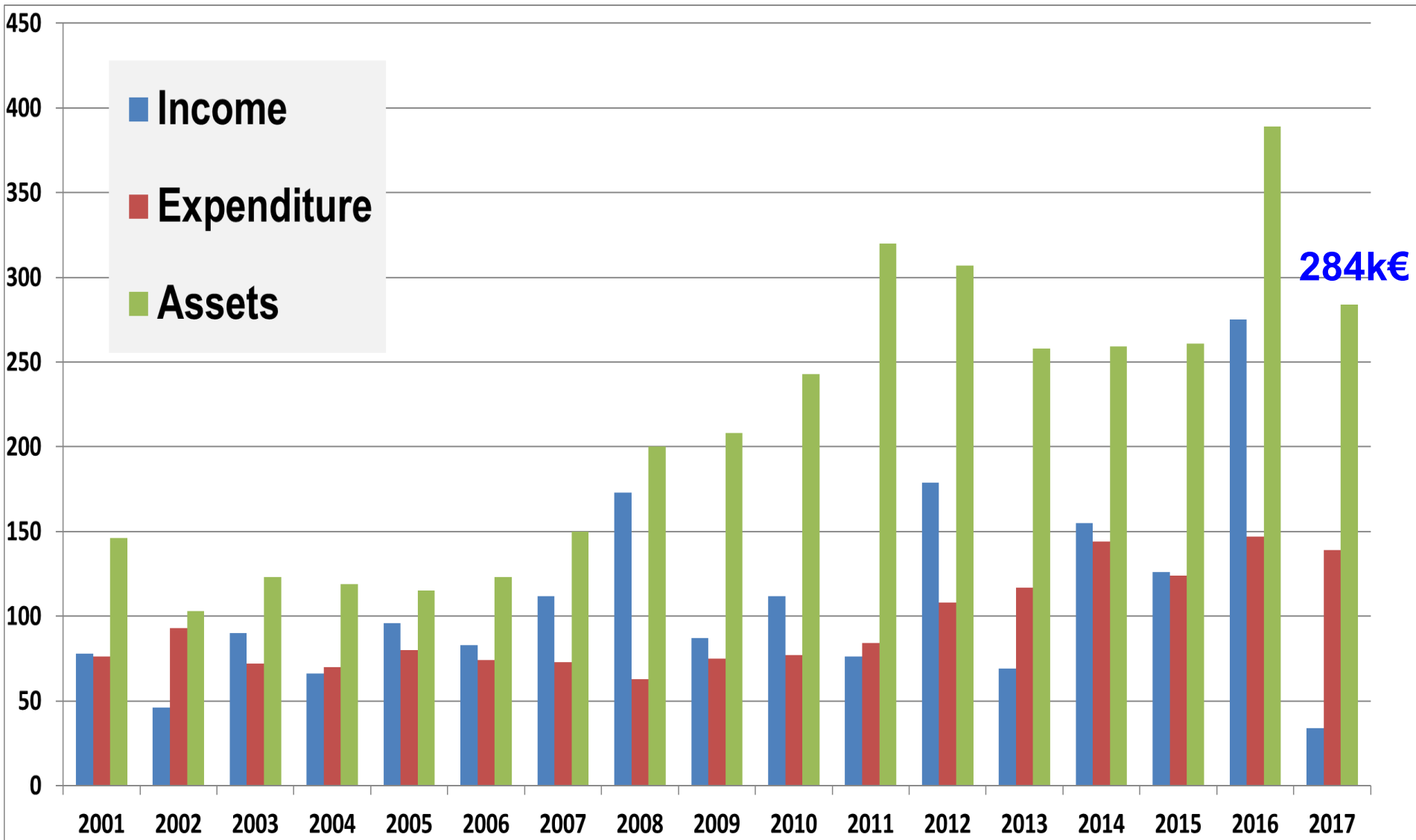

## ◆ Result of 2017

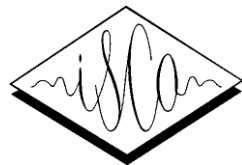
- ◆ Result of income and expenses **paid** in 2017: €-50,628

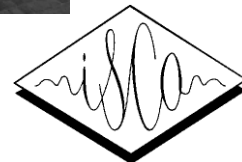
