149 members (146 in-person, 3 remote) were present.

The General Assembly is composed of all full, student and honorary members. An institutional member has only one vote. The General Assembly meets at least every two years. It is convened by the Board or at the request of at least one fifth of its members. Its agenda is proposed by the Board. The President of the Association chairs the meeting. (changes are boldfaced)
